

# Garcia Hall & Piñon Hall Check in

August 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020



**Residents living in Garcia Hall and Piñon Hall** will check in at their scheduled appointment time via a drive through check in process for their respective building by following the above traffic pattern. Everyone must enter the parking lot from the above traffic pattern: Turn off of University Drive onto Triviz Drive, turn onto Arrowhead Drive, then enter the parking lot. All drivers must use the appropriate entrances, exits, obey street signs, and directions from University Police and NMSU staff.

**Piñon Hall residents** will turn off from the traffic pattern to park once they receive their keys (purple arrows).

**Garcia Hall residents** will follow the entire traffic pattern to receive their keys outside of Garcia Hall (orange arrows).

**Please follow these guidelines to ensure a safe check in process:**

- **Masks must be worn at all times by the resident and any helpers. Each resident is allowed only 2 helpers during move in.**
- Carts and dollies will not be provided for use. You may bring your own if needed.
- Please do not exit the vehicle during the drive through check in process.
- You will be asked for the following information upon check in at the tent:
  - Name
  - Aggie ID (will be available for pick up during check in if it is ready)
  - Housing assignment information (available in the MyHousing portal in MyNMSU)
- For first year students, be sure you have uploaded your photo through the [ID Card Services](#) website so your Aggie ID card will be ready when you arrive. Once completed, please email [idsvs@nmsu.edu](mailto:idsvs@nmsu.edu) so they can expedite your request.
- Please be aware of the vehicles and pedestrians around you.
- Everyone is expected to practice proper social distancing guidelines and everyone must wear a mask at all times.
